Defining the System Initialization Routine

NOTE: Luminex recommends weekly calibration and daily performance verification of the MAGPIX system. You can set up the system initialization routine to include calibration and verification on the **Admin** page, **System Setup** tab, **Maintenance Options** section.

- 1. Open the Admin page.
- 2. Click the System Setup tab.
- 3. Under Maintenance Options, choose Fluidics prep, performance verification from the drop-down menu.
- 4. Click Save.

Running the System Initialization Routine

 On the Home page, click System Initialization under Daily Activities. The Auto Maint tab displays. **NOTE:** If the instrument has not been calibrated, **Calibration Verification** will be defaulted on the **Auto Maint** tab. If the instrument has been calibrated, the **Automated Maintenance Option**, as defined, on the **Admin** page will be highlighted.

- 2. Verify that the correct reagents have been added to the correct reservoir or well.
- 3. Click Retract.

4. Click Run.

Shutting Down the MAGPIX®

- On the Home page, click
 Shutdown. The Auto Maint
 tab opens with System
 Shutdown selected.
- 2. Click Eject.

- **3.** Fill reservoir **RA1** with 3/4 of DI water.
- **4.** Fill reservoir **RC1** with 3/4 of 10% to 20% household bleach solution.
- **5.** Verify that reservoir **RD1** is empty.
- **6.** Click **Retract**, then click **Run**.

Running a Post-Batch Routine

NOTE: Luminex recommends running the default Post-Batch routine with 0.1N NaOH after every batch to clean the sample chamber and maintain peak performance. If the default Post-Batch routine is turned off, the Post-Batch routine can be manually executed from the Commands & Routines (**Cmds & Routines**) tab in the **Maintenance** page.

- **1.** Open the **Maintenance** page.
- 2. Click the Cmds & Routines tab.
- 3. Choose the **Post-Batch Routine (Luminex)** from the Routine Name dropdown menu.
- **4.** These are the required reagents:
 - Soak: DI water in RA1
 - Sanitize: IPA in **RB1**
 - Clean: 0.1N NaOH in **RC1**
